- **Activities and Programs Expansion:** Propose to raise the profile/status of NAPE to that of a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) for entrepreneurial development (education) of young professionals and care for the environment (i.e. activities against environmental degradation).
- **Networking Events:** Standardize networking events during the calendar year to be held alternately at locations in the north, south, east and west as may be feasible and safe. Participants to include NAPE members, invitees from Government functionaries as well as other stakeholders in the public and private sectors.
- **STRATCOM Work Support:** Leverage the expertise and experience of members, supported by NAPE, to deliver on the promise of STRATCOM work in seismo-sequence, lithostratigraphic, structural and outstanding biostratigraphic work of the Niger Delta.
